Blisworth Film Club Annual Report 2017/18

As in previous years, the Film Club continues to screen a selection of modern films to suit a varied audience, made up of mainly village residents but with a healthy addition of visitors from surrounding villages and towns. We attract an average of 25 people per month, which enables us to break even and occasionally make a small profit, which is given back to village organisations and charities. This year we have given money to the church, towards their new flooring; we are now looking for another organisation that is needful of funds.

The date of screening has been changed to the fourth Thursday of each month throughout the year, but all other details are the same. Admission £5, own drinks and cushions, no membership and no need to reserve a place. Films have been selected for this coming year, including several blockbusters and highly recommended award winning titles.

The Christmas screening did not take place in December 17, due to lack of a projectionist, but we intend to screen films suitable for young people during this coming year and we encourage parents and grandparents to support this initiative.

As before, publicity is provided by posters, the Village Round And About and the local press.

My continuing thanks go to Beryl Payler and Margaret Murphy for their support, my husband for printing the posters, Anna Hayward at Phoenix, our film provider and all of the people who attend so regularly. We welcome newcomers who can be assured of a warm and friendly evening.
